Text Option Guidelines:

- Times New Roman font
- Font size should be consistent with other elements on the business card, resumé, or related stationery



Logo Option Guidelines:

- Download EAP logo from the Extron website
- Use exactly as shown above
- Logo must not be smaller than 1/2" wide
- Text and logo options cannot be used together
